Jamie was born in Grand Cascapedia, (Gaspé), Quebec, on August 19th, 1915, the youngest of three children of Alvin and Agnes Barter. He is predeceased by his brother, Wesley Barter and his sister, Ada McKinley. Loving husband of Dorothy Burton Barter, deceased (2003). Beloved father of Wendy (Ken) Carruthers and Greg (Muriel) Barter. Grandfather of Gillian (Shane Higginbottom) Barter, Kirstin Barter and Neil Barter and great-grandfather to Aidan Barter.
