Katharine died at the age of 97 at the Brome-Missisquoi Perkins Hospital in Cowansville, on Wednesday January 7, 2015, after a few days of illness. She was born January 28, 1917 in Brockville Ontario, the daughter of Pillans Scarth Stevenson and Mary Katharine McConkey. Katharine had three siblings, Marjorie Winslow, Pillans Scarth Stevenson and Benjamin Ross Stevenson, all of whom predeceased her.

She grew up in Montreal, attending the Montreal High School and Trafalgar School for Girls, and graduating from McGill University in 1939. Katharine married Gordon Taylor Howard in January 1940.
